Directions for Use

Mix uniformly into complete feed or apply as a daily top-dress.

Recommended feeding rates:

- Mature cattle: 28 g per head per day
- Cattle during periods of increased nutritional or environmental stress: 56 g per head per day
- Heifers and calves: 10–14 g per head per day

Feeding rates may require adjustment according to animal weight, life stage, diet composition, production objectives, and environmental conditions. Use according to the approved product label and consult a qualified animal nutritionist or Bionetix® representative for specific feeding guidance.
